Course Description:

Prepares international officers in the grade equivalent to an Air Force major, or junior lieutenant colonel to participate in the Air Command and Staff College (ACSC). Instruction centers on ACSC's book-based curriculum, exploring the works of many great thinkers and strategists and focusing on developing creative, analytical thought and a better understanding of command and application of air power to foster teamwork and team building. Instruction also includes the traditions and ideals of US society, US Defense organization, leadership topics, and language and communicative skills specific to ACSC. The purpose of the course is to develop an awareness of the organizational structure, curriculum content, terminology and instructional methods used at ACSC; an awareness of the United States military mission and organization; and an appreciation of American society, institutions, and ideals. Provides a forum for exchange of ideas, fostering a greater understanding of regional, cultural, and societal issues. Some physical training is accomplished commensurate with ACSC programs. The course is designed to meet individual needs by providing course work based on language fluency. The majority of class time is devoted to lectures and seminars with military or civilian instructors. Local and extended field trips provide students with insights into US society, institutions and ideals. A sponsor program aids students in becoming acquainted with the military and civilian communities.

The International Military Student (IMS) arrival period begins on the posted report date and continues for the next several calendar days. (It is not limited to one day.) SAOs/IMSs should arrange for students to arrive during the arrival period. The IMSO Orientation Brief is the first official IMS formation. It will be conducted on the first Friday following the arrival period. Depending on holidays, this usually allows 3 – 4 days for students to arrive with support from the International Officer School (IOS). Students arriving in Montgomery before the arrival period (i.e., the first date reflected on the ITO) cannot be guaranteed IOS support. Arrival information should be posted on the SANweb no later than (NLT) one month prior to course start date and include the name, age and gender of all family members who will accompany the IMS upon arrival. The Invitational Travel Order (ITO) should be posted to the SANweb NLT one month prior to course start date. It is essential the ITO contains complete and accurate information.

ACSC students will be issued laptops for official use during their educational program. All international students are expected to be proficient in computer use for research projects, test taking, daily schedule review and e-mail correspondence. E-mail is used extensively within the US military as a means of communication.

Health care in the US is not nationalized and without adequate health insurance coverage, it is very expensive. Some countries have reciprocal health care agreements with the US. If the IMS's country does not, he/she must have adequate medical/dental insurance coverage for the duration of their stay in the US (to include a leave period, if authorized, following ACSC graduation). IMSs are required to pay for dependents medical expenses and will show proof of health insurance coverage before departing from country. The IMS and dependents must also be medically vetted prior to departing country.

There are very limited temporary lodging facilities on Maxwell AFB for families. It is probable the IMS who arrives accompanied by dependents will reside in a hotel off base until finding a suitable permanent home or apartment to rent. Housing for unaccompanied students will depend on the country's agreement with the US, but most will live on base. For those who will reside off base, the IOS strongly recommends not signing a rental agreement or lease until visiting the property. Students also need to be aware that where they live designates their children's school district (if a public school) and should take into consideration the quality of local school. The lease should also be reviewed by the Maxwell legal office (a free service). The IOS also recommends purchasing renter's insurance. Whether renting a house, apartment or living in base lodging, this relatively inexpensive insurance offers financial protection against loss or destruction of belongings.

Students should bring the following uniforms with them:

- Service dress (coat and tie) for official photos and social events
- Utility uniform (flight suit or battle dress) for everyday use
- Short and long-sleeved shirts and uniform pants for trip/event requirements

IMSs attending ACSC may be eligible to participate in ACSC's Master's Degree program. This does not change the requirements for IMSs to attend ACSC. Students who attend and satisfactorily

complete graduation requirements will earn a diploma. However, an additional opportunity is available for those who meet Master's Degree admission requirements and wish to apply. Only those who hold a US Bachelor's Degree, or its equivalent, or are admitted based on the portfolio option and meet the English language proficiency requirement are eligible for the Master's Degree program.
