1. I understand that participation in a fully-funded civil schooling program results in a service obligation. (Ref's a, b, and c)

2. If I am selected for the Defense Security Cooperation Agency Global Master of Arts Program, a fully-funded civil schooling program, I agree to complete the schooling and agree that on completion or withdrawal/removal from the school prior to completion, I will serve on active duty for a period equal to three times the length of the schooling, computed in days, unless sooner relieved for the convenience of the Government. (Ref's a, b and c)

3. If I voluntarily, or as a result of misconduct, fail to complete the required service obligation incurred as a result of participation in a fully-funded civil schooling program, I will reimburse the United States an amount determined by multiplying the total cost of education by the proportion of the unserved active duty service obligation. (Ref's a, c and d)
